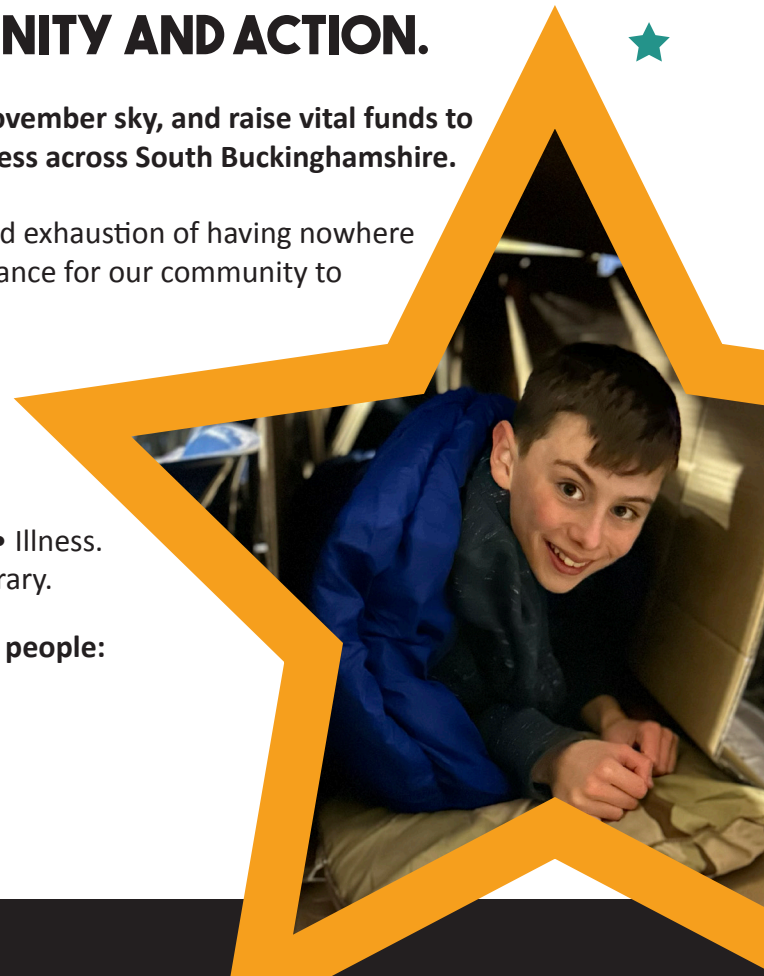
WHY IT MATTERS:

THE CHALLENGE

This year's Sleepout takes place at The Walled Garden. It's a secure overnight venue in West Wycombe with free parking and stewarded support throughout the event.

Sleepouters will build their own shelter using their own kit, materials and creativity. If it's a wet night, cardboard isn't going to cut it!

No overhead cover.

No tents.*

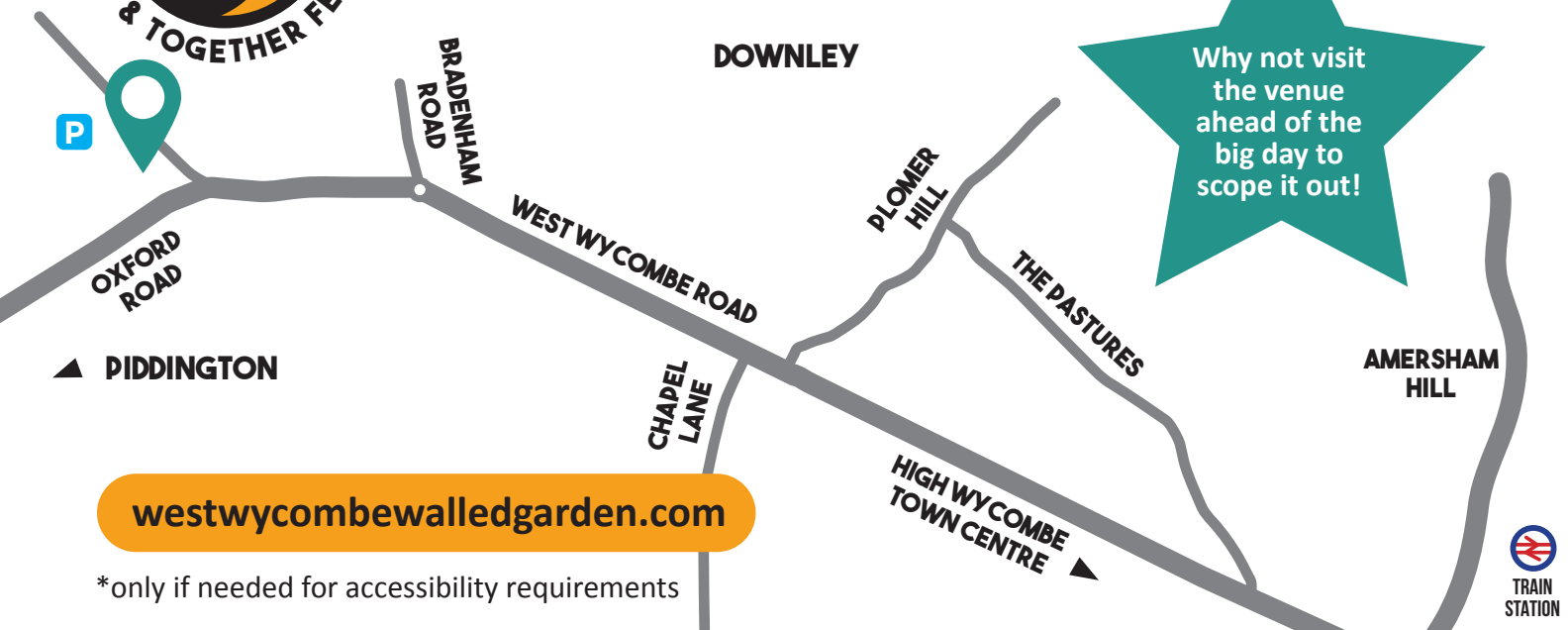
No attaching shelters to walls or buildings.

No easy option.

Terrain: mix of open ground / grass / gravel / paved areas to set up. Shelter planning is part of the challenge. There will be hot food and hot drinks.

WHO CAN TAKE PART?



Minimum age: 12

Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult.

The site is accessible and we will work with you to make sure you can take part.
